Create with me...

Take your child on a short nature walk around your yard, neighborhood, or local park. As you walk, encourage them to collect small, safe items they find interesting—like leaves, pebbles, flowers, sticks, acorns, or pinecones. As they pick up each item, pause and say together, “Thank you, Jesus, for ____”. When you return home, give your child a piece of sturdy paper or cardboard and help them glue their treasures onto it to create a Thankful Collage. At the top, write “Thank You, Jesus, for These Blessings!”

Luke 17:11-19

And it came to pass, as he went to Jerusalem, that he passed through the midst of Samaria and Galilee. And as he entered into a certain village, there met him ten men that were lepers, which stood afar off: And they lifted up their voices, and said, Jesus, Master, have mercy on us. And when he saw them, he said unto them, Go shew yourselves unto the priests. And it came to pass, that, as they went, they were cleansed. And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, and with a loud voice glorified God, and fell down on his face at his feet, giving him thanks: and he was a Samaritan. And Jesus answering said, Were there not ten cleansed? But where are the nine? There are not found that returned to give glory to God, save this stranger. - How many men had leprosy in the story? (10)
- What happened to the lepers while they were walking to the priests? (They were all healed!)
- Why do you think Jesus was sad when only one leper came back? (Because the others didn't say thank you to God.)
- What does this story teach us about being thankful? (We should always say thank you to God when He helps us.)
- Who gets the glory when something good happens in our lives? (God does.)
- Can we still thank Jesus today, even if we don't see Him with our eyes? (Yes! We can pray and tell Him thank you every day.)
